What should I expect?

These interactive workshops will give opportunities for discussion, learning and application of skills you will need in the future, from filling out college forms to hands-on learning of work skills. Prior knowledge is not necessary, just a willingness to learn.

Schools, training programs, and individuals work with Pre-ETS staff using the student's unique goals for postsecondary employment, education and independent living.

What will I do with this knowledge?

Students will apply this knowledge to future work and educational opportunities. Students may wish to pursue more training, at which point a referral to Vocational Rehabilitation should be submitted.
